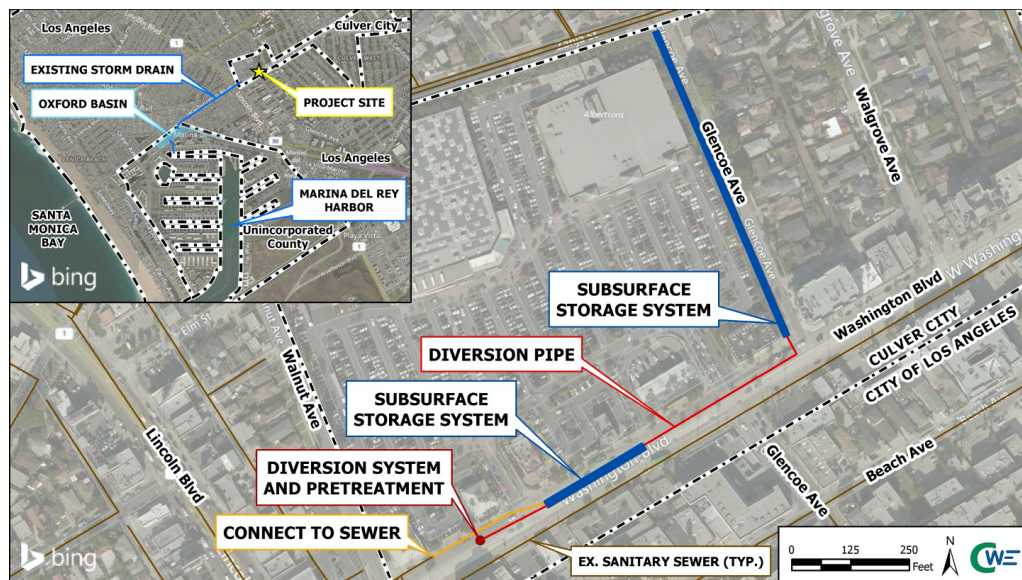
## Virtual Meeting to Discuss the Washington Boulevard Stormwater and Urban Runoff Diversion Project



### WHAT:

In order to comply with stormwater quality mandates for trash, metals, bacteria and other pollutants, the City of Culver City has partnered with Costco to build and operate a stormwater and runoff diversion facility along Washington Boulevard and Glencoe Avenue. The facility will capture dry weather runoff and stormwater and store it for diversion to the sewer system and future irrigation needs. - Comments must be received at least 3 hours in advance of the meeting, otherwise comments must be submitted during the meeting.

- Then, when City staff announce it is the time to take public comment, you will use the "Raise Your Hand" function. When appropriate, you will be unmuted and prompted to make your comment or, if you are unable to speak aloud, you may submit your written comment in the "Chat" box.
