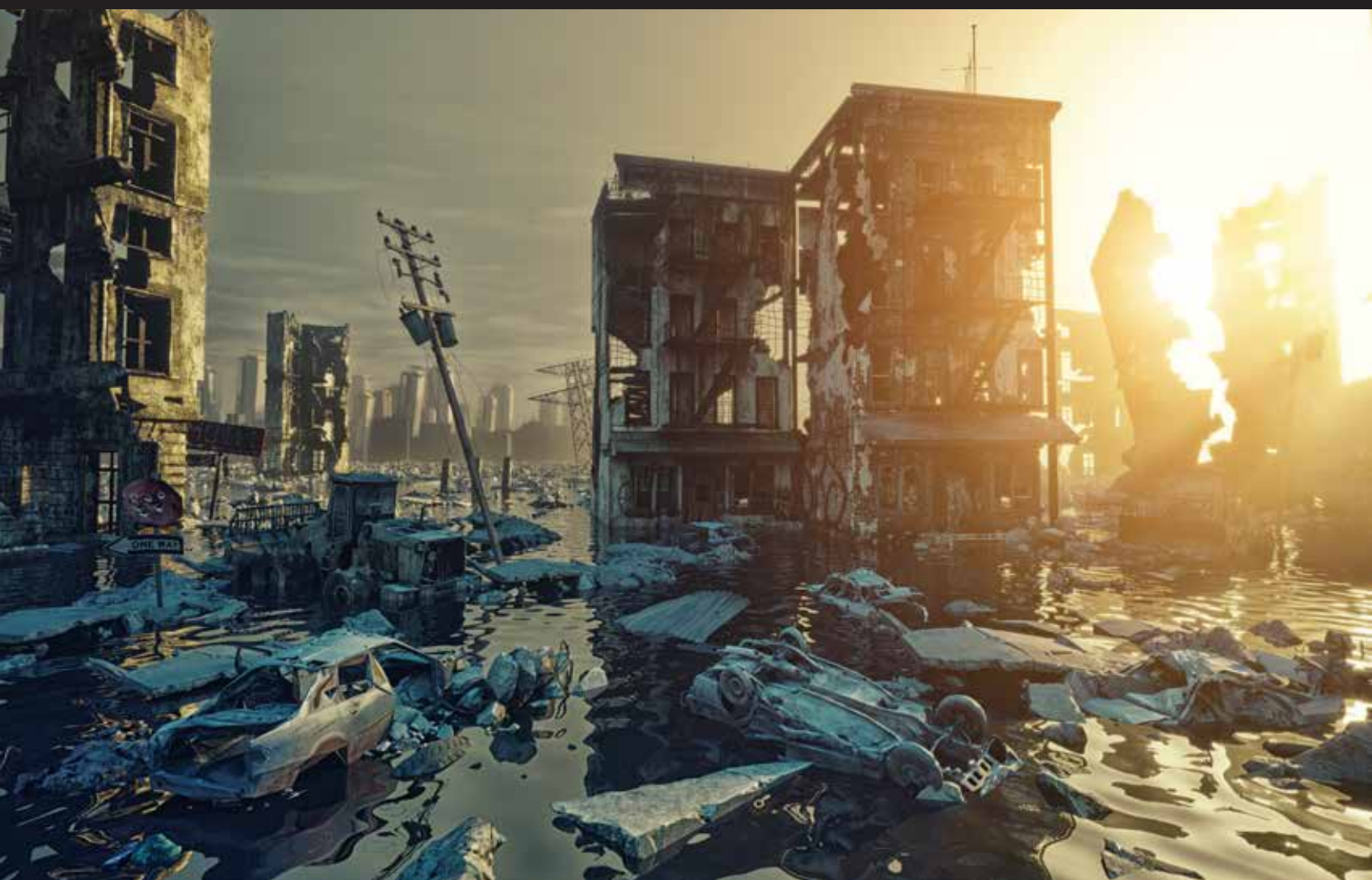


Sixth Annual WVHA Preparedness Fair: Who Pays for Disaster Recovery?



Don't be caught unprepared! July's pair of significant earthquakes once again reminded us about the importance of readiness not only for disaster itself, but also for recovery afterwards.

This year's theme is "Who Pays for Disaster Recovery?" Come meet your neighbors and learn what resources are available and specific steps to take now and after a disaster to promote a smooth and speedy recovery.

We will hear from speakers from the California Earthquake Authority (CEA), the Los Angeles Emergency Management Department (LAEMD), Community Emergency Response Team (CERT) and others on subjects including personal financial preparedness, earthquake and homeowners' insurance, FEMA, and state and local financial resources, and how to organize within your neighborhood to help each other during and after a disaster.

Emergency supply vendors will be on hand so you can learn what new products are available and pick up some items for your home, car, office, and "go" kits. Resource tables staffed by CERT, CEA, LAEMD, LA Fire Department Auxiliary Communications Service (ACS), LA Department of Public Health, and American Red Cross will distribute educational materials and answer your questions. Once again, students from Palms Middle School, wearing their "Master of Disaster" hardhats, will display their preparedness posters and survey attendees on their level of disaster readiness.
