- b. Recruitment of volunteer(s) to compile information and create a "Volunteer Opportunities to Assist the Homeless" pamphlet patterned after Santa Monica City's volunteer opportunities pamphlet with consideration to print. (Funding motion item 7.)
- c. Consideration to print "Healthy Streets" information sheets (copied from L.A. City handout) to post at homeless encampment locations to inform homeless individuals and the community of L.A. City rules and restrictions regarding sleeping on public streets. (Funding motion item 7.)
- d. Homeless Rights to sleep on the streets Jones v. City of L.A.
- e. Guidelines for clean-up of homeless encampments. How to request an encampment clean-up 311, MyLA311 mobile app. How can H.I.C. foster better coordination with service providers (LAHSA, etc.) and LAPD and BOS (Bureau of Sanitation) to effect pre-clean up outreach and proper procedures are followed.

- f. Explanation of and search for potential locations for the Safe Park Park program. Updates on LAMC 85.02 to help reduce the proliferation of vehicle dwelling on Mar Vista Streets.
- g. Affordable housing measures including the Affordable Housing Initiative.
- h. The Source Service Providers offer assistance to the homeless the third Thursday of every month at the Mar Vista library. Their next event is on Thursday, July 19 from 12:00-3:00.
