## RE: "HAWK" CROSSWALK AT SEPULVEDA & CLOVER

Dear Department of Transportation:

There is a crosswalk located at the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard and Clover Ave next to the UCLA University Village Apartments.

This crosswalk is in both a residential and commercial area with a bike lane. The road's average speed is 50mph.

This crosswalk was brought to our attention by stakeholder, Samuel Lutzker, who was almost hit crossing this crosswalk on Nov 12, 2021.

Many people use this crosswalk from the UCLA Family Housing and the current pedestrian signage is ineffective and keeps getting knocked down.

These concerns should be enough reason for LADOT and LA City Council to reevaluate planning in this area.

At the regularly scheduled meeting held February 16, 2022, the Mar Vista Community Council unanimously approved the following policy motion:

The MVCC is FOR a re-evaluation of the safety of the pedestrian crosswalk located at the intersection of Sepulveda Boulevard and Clover Ave next to the UCLA University Village Apartments and consideration of installation of a High Intensity Activated Crosswalk ("HAWK").

We hope our action will result in a "HAWK" crosswalk that will benefit the Community. Please, contact me if any further information or action is needed.
