Parents, teachers, staff, and community partner to develop students' academic excellence, social responsibility and personal integrity.

Clover Avenue Elementary Booster Club is a parent-run, nonprofit, all-volunteer organization that works to support a well-rounded education for all children at the school.

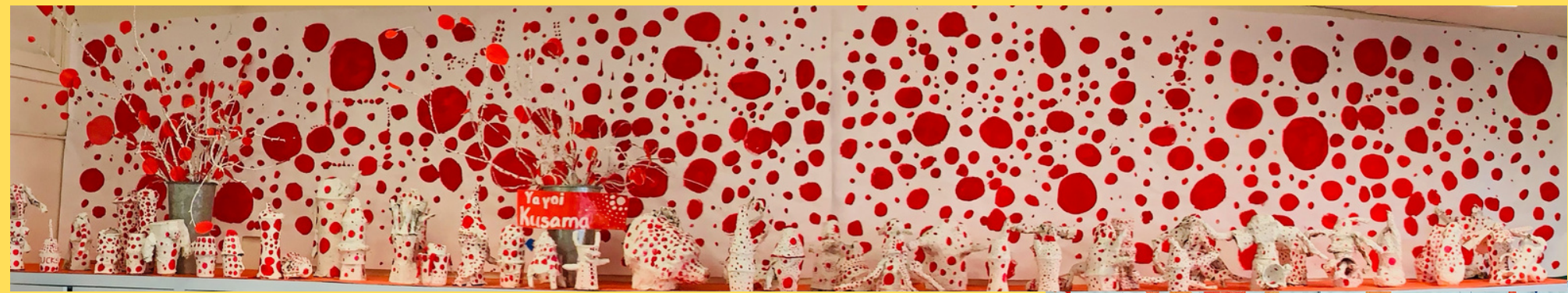

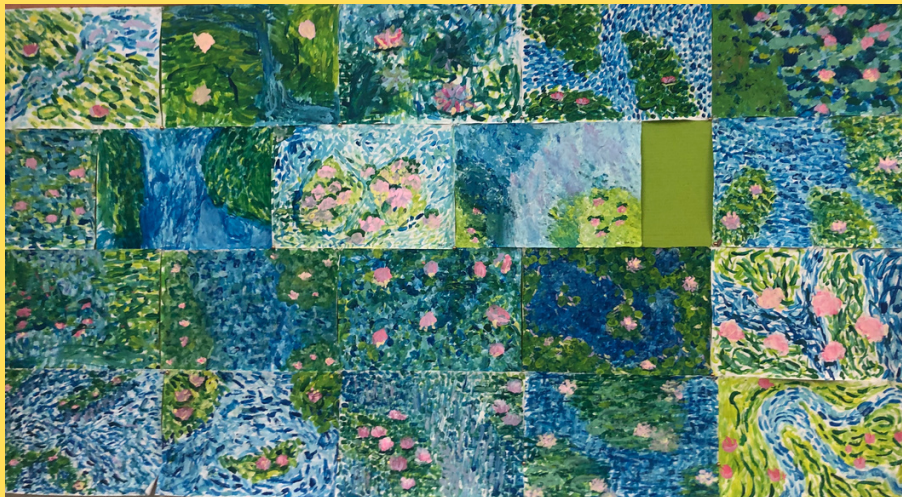
