At its regular monthly meeting February 14, 2012, the Mar Vista Community Council unanimously passed the following Policy Motion regarding support for City of Los Angeles comment on, and a master EIR for, the Bergamot area proposed development plan, Santa Monica, California, reference **Council File 12-0130:**

Whereas the 7-acre development known as the Hines Bergamot Transit Village at 26<sup>th</sup> and Olympic Boulevard in Santa Monica, will have regional traffic and other impacts, the Mar Vista Community Council supports review and comment on the project's Draft Environmental Impact Report by the City of Los Angeles, by and through its City Attorney, City Council, responsible City departments and CalTrans. The MVCC further supports a comprehensive EIR on the entire 140-acre Bergamot Area presently being planned by the City of Santa Monica under a HUD Grant. MVCC recommends careful analysis of the cumulative regional impacts upon the City of Los Angeles including all pending and anticipated development projects in CD11 and CD5.
