TITLE: Street Hump Applications 2024

COMMITTEE: Transportation, Infrastructure, and Sustainability (T&I) Committee

THE MOTION: The Mar Vista Neighborhood Council asks that LADOT strongly prioritize speed hump installation in areas near schools and slow residential streets that currently act as cut-through streets; specifically we request that LADOT strongly consider Mar Vista applications on the following streets: Walgrove near the elementary school, Rose in Zone 1, ... In addition, and most importantly, we are extremely concerned about the lack of transparency around this process and request that LADOT report back to neighborhood councils about the number and location of speed hump requests, the prioritization of those requests by LADOT, and the order in which approved requests are to be implemented.

BACKGROUND: LADOT installs street humps in residential areas according to a very specific eligibility process and application cycle, opening applications once per year which typically exceed capacity within the first 5-15 minutes. This process makes it extremely difficult for neighbors to efficiently and effectively get transportation safety issues addressed in their neighborhood. It also makes it difficult for the neighborhood councils to help prioritize and provide input on which streets urgently need humps, based on the cumulation of requests from the community over time, including residents who may not have the time nor be aware of this annual application process. Not only do we hope that LADOT will strongly consider applications in the areas we highlighted, but we also hope that LADOT will keep us informed and involved throughout the selection process so that we may provide greater transparency and support to our constituents.
