<u>THE MOTION:</u> The Mar Vista Community Council <u>supports</u> the City's motion to update the Los Angeles Green Building Code and address embodied carbon in the built environment.

BACKGROUND: In order for the City to meet ambitious GHG emission reduction targets, it is imperative to address carbon emissions from building materials. The impact of development is on display in our community, and yet greenhouse gas emissions are invisible and often an afterthought when there is a development boom. We must change that if we are to meet the Sustainable City Plan for all buildings to be net zero by 2050 and the City's commitment to reducing embodied carbon for major construction (~buildings greater than 50,000 square feet) by 50% before 2030. This file should generate the kind of enforcement of the Los Angeles Green Building Code that will meet the current and future needs of Mar Vista and Los Angeles residents.
