We would like you to evaluate the need for protected left turn signals at the intersection of Overland Ave. and Palms Blvd. in all directions. Given the ever-growing congestion that takes place between this corridor of the 10 and the 405, not having a left-turn signal is causing dangerous driving maneuvers, such as, but not limited to, running yellow and red lights, blocking traffic, and speeding. Additionally, the lack of a protected left signal has caused even greater congestion, often causing a standstill where drivers cannot turn during high traffic hours.

We would like to request an evaluation that clarifies:

- What threshold exists to designate a left-turn signal (and not just a left-turn lane)
- Whether this intersection meets that threshold in all directions
- And informs the Mar Vista and Palms NCs of the criteria and your decision to install a protected left-turn signal at this intersection

It is of this committee's resolve to investigate protected left-turn signal at Overland Ave. and Palms Blvd. to build a safer and more accommodating driving experience for our stakeholders.
