LADOT Agenda Items

Old Business – Progress Reports & Further Discussion of tabled items from the Sept. 20th Meeting:

Item #1: Follow-up report from Rudy G. re: current status as to LADOT putting a left turn signal at Sawtelle and Charnock, to enable drivers to make a left turn at the 4-way signal at the Sawtelle/Charnock intersection, whether a presentation has been made to the MVCC BOD and the results, and whether or not a decision has been reached as to installation of this signal. [LADOT]

Item #2: Follow-up report by Rudy G. as to the current status re: installation of a stakeholder-requested 4-way STOP at the intersection of Barry/Colbert and Federal, replacing a 2-way STOP for traffic on Barry/Colbert to improve visibility of oncoming cars on Barry. [LADOT]

New Business – Items for Discussion:

Item #1: A stakeholder requests installation of a STOP sign on Gateway Blvd. between Barrington and Bundy as a measure to reduce numerous accidents in this section where Gateway curves and creates several intersections with poor visibility, and apparently also induces drivers to speed. [LADOT]

Item #2: Report from Rudy G. re: updating of timing to install protected-only phasing for the left-turn westbound traffic signal on Ocean Park Blvd. at Centinela Ave., and verification that timing for “all-red” is up to new standards for this intersection. [LADOT]

Other Agenda Items:

Old Business – [Note: Refer to July 19, 2017 Minutes for details on record for these two items.]

Item #1: Follow-up report from Len N. re: a study of a stakeholder’s request that street lights be installed on Victoria Ave. between Walgrove Ave. and Beethoven St. as there presently is no street lighting; stakeholder says street is “super dark” at night and installing lights is a matter of nighttime safety for residents on and visitors to this street. Report shall include whether DWP will install lights and when, or if there is an alternative installation plan. [CD11]

Item #2: Follow-up reports from Len N. and Officer Lawrence re: solving speeding and parking problems as reported by a block captain for the section of Inglewood Blvd. between Palms and National Blvds. [CD11 & LAPD]

New Business –

Item #1: Resident stakeholders report having a “major issue” with cut-through traffic on Inglewood Blvd. between National Blvd. and Navy St. daily from 7-9 AM and 4:30-7PM, with lots of vehicles driving well over the speed limit and few even slowing for the speed bump on the street, an request some help from LAPD to resolve the speeding problem. [LAPD]
