

**Neighborhood Councils – Department of Water and Power
Memorandum of Understanding Oversight Committee**

Meeting Notes

Saturday, December 2, 2017, 8:45 a.m.

1. This meeting was chaired by Tony Wilkinson.
2. The two members, Tony Wilkinson and Jack Humphreville, of the Citizen Committee for the Selection of the Executive Director of the Office of Public Accountability gave a status report. They expect the selection process to be completed by the end of this fiscal year (June 30, 2018).
3. **Presentation by Donald Sievertson, Manager of Energy Control and High Voltage Stations.**

The LADWP is vitally dependent on natural gas supplied through Southern California Gas Company's pipelines for the generation of most of their electricity and pumping most of their water. The unavailability of the Aliso Canyon storage facility and three major pipeline outages at Southern California Gas Company increase the risk of service curtailments by the DWP this winter. On October 30th, Southern California Gas Company stated that noncore curtailments are likely this winter. Noncore customers include refineries, large hospitals and manufacturing. Residences will be the last to be cut back because of the size of the effort to relight pilot lights. Much will depend on the weather.
