The Palms Neighborhood Council and the Mar Vista Community Council would like to bring to attention the need for a protected left turn signal in all directions at Overland Avenue and Palms Boulevard. We are aware that there is a protected left turn signal heading eastbound on Palms Boulevard turning onto Overland already. Given the number of collisions at this intersection, not having a left turn signal in all directions is causing dangerous driving maneuvers such as but not limited to:

- running red lights
- speeding through yellow lights
- endangering oncoming car traffic, cyclists, and pedestrians

It is of the Palms Neighborhood Council and the Mar Vista Community Council's resolve to request a protected left-turn signal in all directions at Overland Avenue and Palms Boulevard to build a safer and more accommodating driving experience for our stakeholders.

As part of the City's response, we would like to clarify:

- What thresholds exist to designate a left-turn signal (and not just a left-turn lane)
- Why this intersection did not have protected left-turn signals in all directions in the first place
- How these criteria inform your decision to install a protected left-turn signal at this intersection
